Autocross. It's been one of our most popular activities over the years at Central Wisconsin Region. Some of our events will get 15 or more cars with very involved, active participants. Last year our home track Columbus 151 Speedway was sold to Madison College and is no longer available for rental. We asked and were in no uncertain terms told to go away....not interested.

We've approached our old venue from the 80's and 90's, the Alliant Energy Center, and were also told they aren't interested in automotive type events with moving vehicles in their parking lots.

Last summer, Gregg Elliott contacted several school districts in Southern Wisconsin and found that the Janesville Parker High School was open to our competitive events for donations to their athletic booster club. We signed on for two autocross events last year for a contribution of \$200 per event. We loved it, the parking lots were a great place for autocross. We ran several safe, fun events there and wanted to do more. Other than a concerned citizen who called the police on us, everything was good.

This year we signed up for four events at Janesville Parker. We completed two events and as usual, we were courteous to others using the property, we cleaned up after ourselves, and were fully insured by PCA. We ran a controlled, safe event. We contributed \$400 to the Parker booster club.


After the July event, for whatever reason, we have been told that we had to cancel our remaining events at Janesville Parker parking lots this year. We were given a partial explanation about some repaving, but we're really not sure about that. There were reports of several people driving into the lot for an event at the school and a man walked over to the side of the lot and watched us for a while with what was

described to me as a "disapproving look" on his face.

Apparently, someone has an issue with autocross, so once again we are looking for a place to hold our events. If anyone knows of a large hard surface parking lot for rent, at a reasonable price, please contact us.

We're insured, safe and we pay our bills.
