It looks like we've lost our home racetrack, possibly for good. Columbus 151 Speedway has been sold. Rumor has it that it was purchased by MATC for their police training program. One message I heard about the sale is that MATC may not be interested in renting the track to outside parties, particularly miscreant hot rodders like Porsche Club of America. You know, the same reckless fools who buy expensive sports cars, fix them up and care for them only to go out to some track to destroy them? Yeah, us.

We've had similar discussions in the past with the people who run the Alliant Energy Center. In the late 1980's and early 90's, CWI-PCA ran some great autocross events there when it was still the Dane County Coliseum. We would attract in excess of 25 cars, and really built up the treasury in those days. After some disagreements with another club, who used our insurance for joint events, we stopped using that venue and found Columbus 151. In hindsight, maybe we should have continued to do at least one event each year so we could establish a reputation for the next round of management. We approached the AEC management two years ago and inquired about using a section of parking lot for an autocross event and were generally rebuffed and looked upon as a bunch of troglodytes who wanted to murder the earth with our fossil fueled beasts.

One of our members has explored some back roads in the old Army Ammunition Plant site north of Sauk City. He says there are some pretty fantastic paved roads back there that would make a great road course for Porsches. Does anyone know if rental might be possible or who we could call to ask?

Right now, other than Sugar River Raceway, which is very expensive to rent and difficult to schedule, we are homeless for our competitive events.

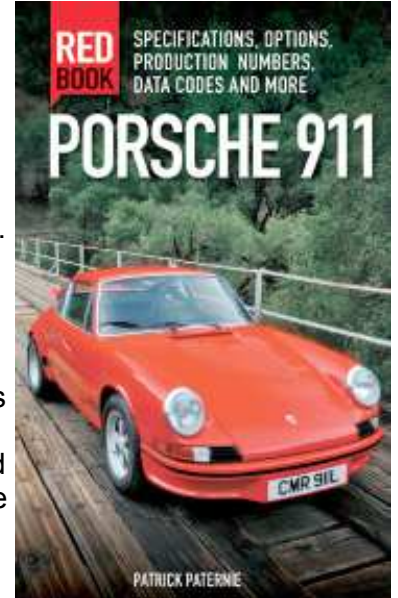
