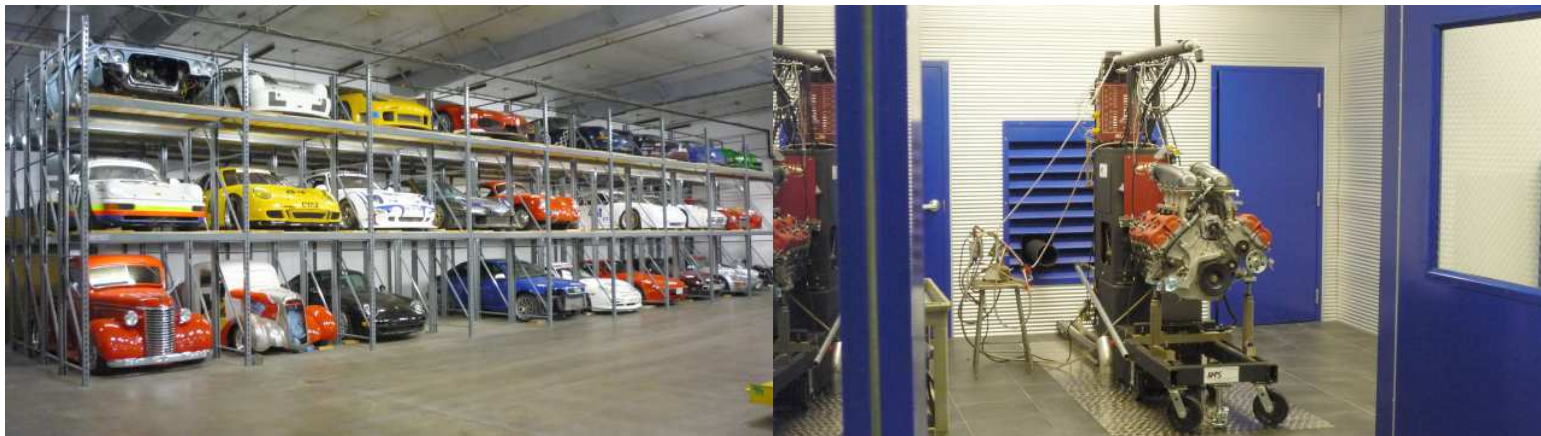

Roads Scholar Rally

The Sports Car Club of America would like to extend an invitation to all of the members of CWA - PCA to join us for the 2016 Roads Scholar Road Rally. This year's event will be on Sunday, June 12, 2016 and will again start and finish in Verona, just 15 minutes south of Madison. Like last year's event, this road rally is designed especially for people who have never run a road rally before. The rally is 100 miles in length and takes about 4 hours to complete. The course runs entirely on paved, public roads.

Two weeks before the rally we'll email the General Instructions to all contestants. These explain the details of how the rally works. Basically, you and a partner (driver and navigator) will be issued a set of Route Instructions on the morning of the rally. You'll use these Route Instructions to follow the course. Each road on the course is assigned an average speed (below the posted speed limit). The game is to follow the course and maintain the assigned average speeds. Along the route, you'll be tested on your powers of observation, reasoning, and ability to follow explicit directions. We'll set up checkpoints along the route that will record the time that you arrive. You'll receive penalty points for arriving either too early or too late. The team with the fewest penalty points wins. Trophies will be awarded to the best teams. The entry fee is \$15/person and you'll need two people per car - a driver and a navigator.

Pre-registration is required, you can't show up on the day of the event and register.
