

Porsche made history when it brought turbocharging to the racing world in the form of the 917. In its wildest trim, the original 12-cylinder turbocharged Porsche racing engine yielded as much as 1,400 horsepower! Leffingwell is considered one of the top Porsche historians working today, and he enjoys a close working relationship with Porsche AG. He lives in southern California, about 100 miles north of Los Angeles.

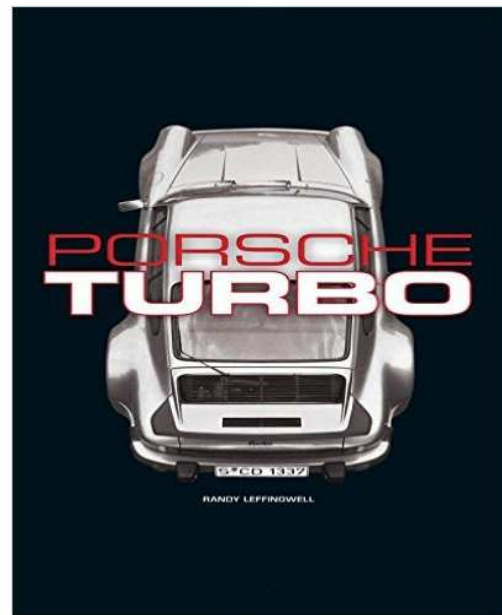

It looks as if we have a new site for autocross. Gregg Elliott talked with officials at the Janesville Parker High School and they agreed to let us use the parking lot for two autocross events in September in exchange for a generous donation to the booster club.. We hauled as many cones as we have down to Janesville and we used them all. It's a great location. Lots of wide open blacktop.

We ran the two events with a couple of different courses and it looks like there are many options for variations of the course, so we can keep things interesting. The pavement is very good with few obstructions and there are actually two lots we can use, and we did. We set up a course that allowed us to drive between both lots.

There was one little glitch that we didn't think of and that was, what would be the reaction from passers by or neighbors to the sight of several Porsches flying around the high school parking lot. On our second event we noticed a pickup truck that stopped and watched us for a while, then drove off. We didn't think much of it until a Janesville police car pulled into one of the blocked off entrances to the lot, and just sat there watching. After the car on the course at the time was finished with their run we waived the officer over to the timing area. He was very polite. He asked us what we were doing, and who had given permission for these cars racing in the school parking lot.

Luckily, Gregg was there at the event and he gave the officer the names and numbers for the people who had given us permission. He left, saying he would check them out and get back to us if there was a problem. We never heard from him again. For future events we will contact Janesville police and let them know when we will be there so if they get a call from a concerned citizen, they will know we are OK to be there.

We definitely will be looking at a few dates there next summer.
