

They were split into three groups depending on driving skills and got a lot of track time. The event was sponsored by three private business leaders from the Fox Valley area and all entry fees were donated to various charities.

Denny Lamers is the organizer of the event and races in the Trans Am type series. They had approximately 100 cars in three different groups: Race, Fast Street, and Street. Each group got five track sessions of 20 minutes per session.
